There are several simple and flexible ways to create a legacy that aligns with your personal, financial, and family priorities.

GIFTS THROUGH YOUR WILL OR TRUST

One of the most common ways to create a legacy is by including Griffin Hospital in your will. You may choose to leave a specific dollar amount, a percentage of your estate, or what remains after your loved ones are cared for. These gifts are flexible and can be updated at any time.

How to do it:

Speak with your attorney or estate planner and ask to include Griffin Hospital as a beneficiary in your will or trust. You can also add or update this provision at any time by creating a simple amendment (codicil or trust update).

RETIREMENT ACCOUNT BENEFICIARY DESIGNATIONS

You can name Griffin Hospital as a full or partial beneficiary of an IRA, 401(k), or other retirement account. Because these assets may be subject to income tax when left to individuals, they can be a particularly meaningful and tax-efficient way to create a legacy gift.

How to do it:

Contact your retirement plan custodian (such as your IRA provider, bank, or financial advisor) and request a beneficiary designation form. You can list Griffin Hospital as a full or partial beneficiary directly on the form.

LIFE INSURANCE BENEFICIARY GIFTS

A life insurance policy that is no longer needed for its original purpose can become a powerful legacy gift. You may name Griffin Hospital as a full or partial beneficiary.

How to do it:

Contact your life insurance company or agent and request a change of beneficiary form. You can name Griffin Hospital as a primary or contingent beneficiary.

DONOR ADVISED FUNDS

If you have a donor advised fund through a community foundation such as the Valley Community Foundation, or another financial institution, you may name Griffin Hospital as a successor or final beneficiary, ensuring your charitable intentions continue beyond your lifetime.

How to do it:

Contact your donor advised fund sponsor and request a beneficiary designation form. You can name Griffin Hospital as a final or successor beneficiary to receive remaining funds.
